He has illustrated two World Book Day titles and regularly appears at literary festivals, live events and schools across the UK.

Steven has his own Draw-Along-A-Lenton YouTube channel, showing you how to draw a range of his characters, and he was in the Top 20 Bookseller Bestselling Illustrator Chart 2019.

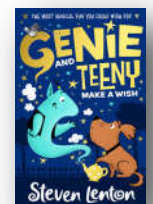
